

NEW 2018 CERAMIC TILE PROJECT FOR HUNSTANTON SEA FRONT.

This season Paint Me Ceramics and the HDFA are joining together once again to help cheer up the promenade with colourful hand painted original ceramic tiles designed by locals and visitors to the town.

This seasons theme is “Under the Sea” and these tiles will join the 6 panels already completed on the sea wall. This project has been running since 2012 and is the latest stage to be attempted - there are 9 panels in all to be completed.

Each Tile will cost just £10.00. This is subsidised by the HDFA to include special paints, tiles and assisted studio time for painting and firing.

You can either go to the Paint Me Ceramic studios in Westgate Hunstanton during opening hours or visit their open- air Marquee at the Hunstanton Carnival on June 24th.

Later in the year these tiles will form part of the permanent display on the North Promenade and if you sign your own work of art - it will be there forever!

This is just one of the HDFA’s ongoing projects, which include Live Music “At the Spinney” in Hunstanton High Street, an Open Air professional Theatre performance of Pride & Prejudice at Thornham Village Hall grounds in August and a Festival of One Act Plays at the Princess Theatre, Hunstanton from July 6-8th.
